Volunteers and Visitors

If you would like to volunteer, you must submit a background check application with Seattle Public Schools. These background checks may take up to four weeks to complete so you should submit one at the beginning of the year to make sure you'll be eligible to volunteer for opportunities. If you have volunteered in the past you may need to update your application. Volunteer clearances are valid for two calendar years. If you are visiting or volunteering at the school you are required to sign in at the front office and wear a volunteer/visitor badge before entering the classrooms or hallways.

Early Check Out

If it is necessary for your child to leave school early, you must sign your child out at the front office. It is best to email the office and your child's teacher in advance. Please leave extra time as the office staff will need to call your student from class.

Morning Drop Off and Afternoon Pick Up

Drop-off and Pick-up can be quite hectic around the school so please observe the following guidelines to keep our students safe:

- Do not park in the drop off lane in front of the school. This lane is for children exiting the car quickly. Have your child ready to go before you get in the line.
- If you would like to walk your child to the front door please park in a legal parking spot in the neighborhood. Do not park in the drop off lane.
- Cross only at crosswalks. Do not cross in the middle of the street.
- Speed limit in front of the school is 15 mph.
- Parking around the school is limited. Do not park within 30 feet of a stop sign or within 20 feet of a marked or unmarked crosswalk.
- No U-turns on 24th Avenue, or using 91st Street to make a U-turn.
- No parking in the bus zone (even when no buses are present)
- Parallel parking only in front of the house at the NW corner of 24th and 91st. Let's also be good neighbors and not block their mailbox.
- No parking facing the wrong direction.
- Do not leave your car running, if unattended.
- Do not leave your child unattended in a running car.
- Seattle Police regularly patrol the area and will issue tickets.
- Please do not block neighboring driveways.

North Beach PTA, putting the fun in fundraising!

The North Beach Elementary PTA will host three fundraisers this year to raise money that directly supports our classrooms, teachers, students, and school. The PTA allocates approximately \$638 per student in academic support, critical staffing, and community engagement. This fundraising is critical to the PTA and the wellbeing of the school socially and academically.

The Big Give, 11/7 - 11/18

The Big Give is North Beach PTA's direct giving fundraiser. During the two week campaign students and families are invited to participate in a variety of games, donation challenges, and classroom competitions. The fundraising goal for The Big Give is \$75,000.

The Auction- North Beach Rocks!, 4/22

Dust off your air guitar and get ready for a rockin' night out! This parent night out is North Beach PTA's largest fundraiser. Featuring interactive games, a silent and live auction, and, rumor has it, karaoke, this will be a night to remember. The fundraising goal for the auction is \$150,000.

Move-a-Field Day, 6/20

Long name, fun time! This fundraiser combines the fun of a jog-a-thon with the adventure of field day. Students pledge to complete specific passport paths with a variety of fun challenges while raising money for our school. The fundraising goal for Move-a-Field Day is \$20,000.

Corporate Matching

As a registered 501c3, North Beach PTA qualifies for corporate matching programs. These matches provide significant financial support for the school. Volunteer Opportunities

North Beach Elementary is fortunate to have a wonderful parent community that is united behind the goal of creating lifetime learners. Parent volunteers are a huge part of what makes North Beach a wonderful place for our children to learn and grow.

Volunteering at North Beach provides a great opportunity to provide invaluable assistance to teachers and staff, get to know other families at school, make great friends, have lots of fun, and help us grow as a school community, whether you help from school or from home.

We all have something to contribute. Below is a listing of various ways you can volunteer your talents at North Beach. We welcome your involvement as a volunteer!

If you only have time to volunteer every once in a while:

- **Sign up to be a lunch volunteer.** Lunch volunteers help students in the lunchroom (getting their lunches, opening packages, sorting trash) and help keep the lunchroom clean in between lunches. It is best if volunteers can come in at least once a month.
- **Volunteer for PTA events.** During the school year, the PTA needs parent volunteers to run their events such as Harvest Carnival, the Auction, Book Exchange BINGO, Walk-a-Jog-a Field Day, and more. These events happen during and after school and offer a variety of time options.
- **Volunteer in the classroom.** Parents in the classroom enhance the learning experience for all. Ask your student's teacher when they need help and let them know what your schedule allows.

If you have time to volunteer after work or in the evenings:

Join a Committee! The North Beach PTA sponsors a wide variety of family and student programs and activities throughout the year. Committee meetings are held mostly in the evenings and many can be done online. Committee commitments vary depending on the event and can vary from one month (for example Giving Tree) to a school year long commitment (the Auction).

One to Two Months Commitment:

- Giving Tree and North Beach Appreciation Week: North Beach is a giving community and we love to give within our school and the surrounding community. These two committees usually meet for about a month, including implementing the programs. Teams work collaboratively with community members within North Beach and the surrounding area to spread kindness and goodwill. Meetings are usually held online and are flexible to the needs of the committee.
- Single Day Activities: these fun committees usually meet for about two months weekly and then bi-weekly if needed as the event draws nearer. Meetings times vary depending on the availability of the committee and usually last no more than an hour. The day of the event, the committee and other day of volunteers work together to host these exciting school wide events.
 - Committees include: Harvest Carnival, Veteran's Day Assembly, Book Exchange BINGO, Rain or Shine Garden Party, Talent Show, Walk-aJog-a Field Day
- The Big Give: The PTA's direct giving fundraiser has about a 2 month commitment and usually meets in the evening, mostly virtually, every two weeks and then weekly as the event nears. This committee has opportunities for everyone: from the lover of excel files to writing copy to getting face to face with North Beach families to raise awareness of the campaign.

Volunteer Opportunities Continued

3 Month Commitment:

- Kindergarten Ambassadors: Do you have an incoming kinder student for next year? This committee is a great way to welcome new families and incoming students. The committee organizes and implements summer playdates and an informational online meeting for incoming families questions. The committee usually meets weekly for about a month before school ends and during summer events. Meetings and event times are flexible according to the group's needs.
- 5th Grade Camp and Promotion: 5th grade is a special time for our students. The 5th grade promotion and camp committee ensure that all 5th grade students have a welcoming and fun departure from North Beach. Committee meetings are flexible to the needs of the committee.
- Nominating Committee: easily one of the most important committees at North Beach is the Nominating Committee. This committee actively seeks the future leaders of the PTA. This committee's meetings are flexible and depend on the availability of its members. The committee meets from December until May.

School Year Long Commitment:

- Enrichment: this important committee needs committed volunteers to help get students to their after school activities, monitor classes during the session, and ensure students are picked up by an authorized caregiver. Volunteers can help during specific sessions of the year.
- The Auction: as our largest fundraiser, the Auction is a committee that meets throughout the year starting monthly and becoming more frequently closer to the event. Meetings are usually held in the evening and the committee has a variety of volunteer opportunities from organizing classroom donations and dessert dash to
- Yearbook: want a fun and easy way to make lasting memories! Join the yearbook committee. This year long commitment gets to tap into the fun side of North BEach and preserve it for our students. Committee meetings vary and are flexible to the needs of its members. Volunteer opportunities are abundant from gathering pictures, to layout and design, and family outreach.
- Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Committee: The DEI Committee is a year long commitment with flexible meeting times based on the needs of its members.. The committee advises and makes recommendations to the North Beach PTA's policies and practices to create a more diverse, equitable, and inclusive environment and to ensure all events, communication, and more are inclusive and equitable to a wide range of human diversity. The committee is looking for people who are passionate about Diversity, Equity and Inclusion and are committed to inclusive outcomes for the North Beach Community. The committee will work together to identify focus for the school year.

PTA Suggestions for Parent and Caregiver Relations

Good communication is key to maintaining a strong relationship between you and your child's teachers. Here are a few Herbie approved tips that can be helpful to foster healthy communication.

Find the right time to speak to the teacher or staff member.

Check in with your student's teacher to see if they have time to speak. If not, work together to set up a convenient time to meet. Drop off and pick up can be especially busy times for teachers and staff. It is always a good idea to check in with a teacher before you drop in to chat.

Be brief and specific in written communications.

The more specific you can be about a concern or issue, the easier it is for your child's teacher to respond or offer suggestions.

Recognize stylistic differences.

Everyone is different when it comes to parenting, learning, and communications. Recognize that you may have stylistic differences than your child's teacher.

If you are able, volunteer!

Volunteering in the classroom and school is a great way to get to know your student's teacher and classroom. Volunteering is different for every teacher and they will communicate their needs.

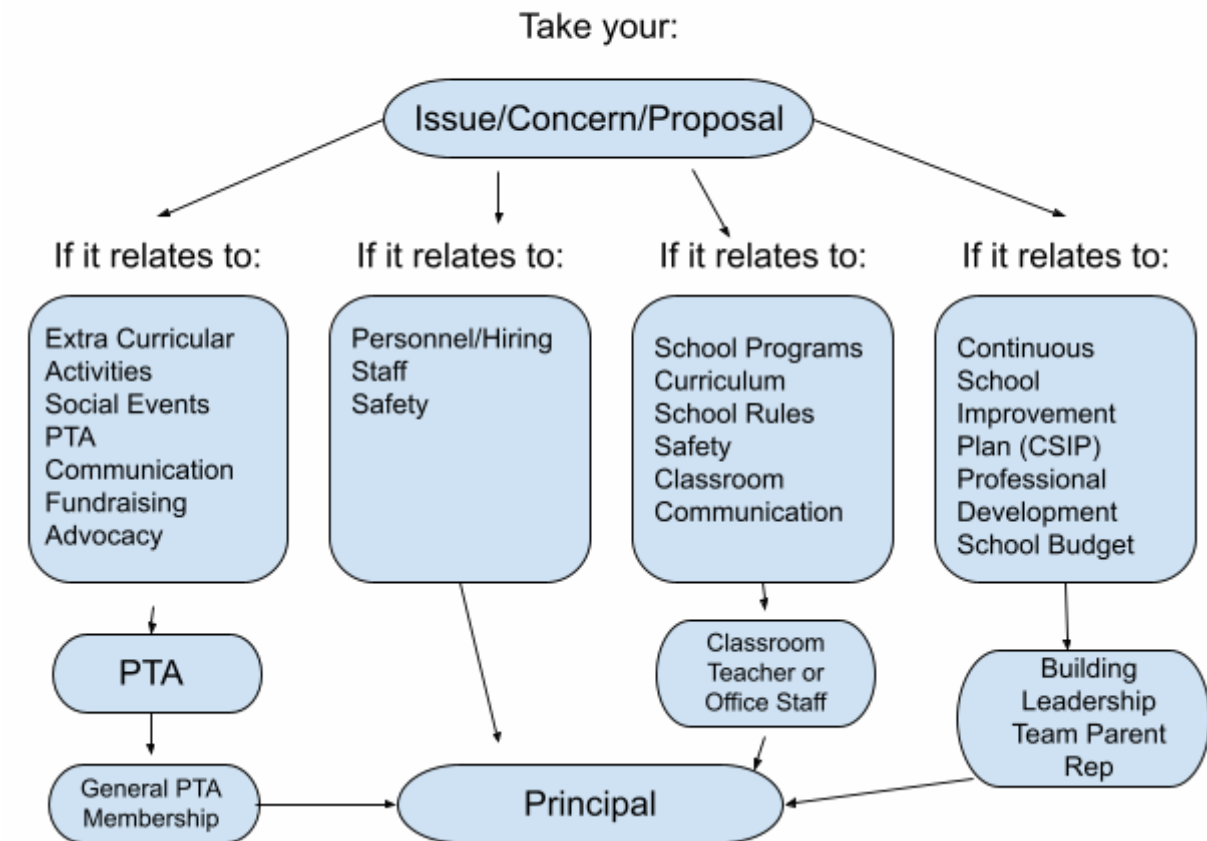
Preparing for Parent Teacher Conferences

Parent Teacher conferences can be over in a flash, it is helpful to be prepared. Conferences are the perfect opportunity to share questions, concerns, and collaborations to help your student get the most out of their classroom experience. Don't forget to speak with your child a few days before conferences. This is a great way to hear from them how things are going, what they like most or least, and if they have any questions or concerns.

Some questions that may be helpful in conferences:

- What are my child's strengths/weaknesses in class?
- Does my student need any additional support in a particular area, how can I support them at home?
- Does my child participate in class/turn their work in on time/ meet classroom behavior expectations?
- Does my student have friend support from their peers?
- How can I challenge my student at home?

Decision Making:

BLT: By consensus, if no consensus reached, by majority vote.

Seattle Education Association (SEA) Represented Staff: By consensus, if not reached, by 75% majority vote, if a majority vote cannot be achieved, then the principal may select from among the options voted upon. The principal will give rationale for the choice made.

Principal: Principal will give rationale for the choice made.

PTA: PTA board will bring a recommendation to a general PTA meeting for a majority vote.

Consensus means: support, accept or abide by the decision even if you have reservations about the decision.
